

# 3B Medical Product Training/Competency Checklist

This competency checklist is designed to be used as a guide for record of training on 3B Products and Accessories. It is not intended to replace reading and understanding instruction manuals, individual assessment or competency of use of the product(s).

NOTE: All CPAP/Bi-Level Products will be referred to as RESmart PAP Device. All Interfaces will be referred to as "Interface".

Topic	Description	Completed (Y / N?)
Opening Box/Carry Bag. Verifying Components.	Will be able to remove CPAP from box/carry bag, verify all components are present and in good condition.	
Identify Parts of RESmart PAP Device and Accessories.	Will be able to identify all parts of the CPAP, including accessories, power connection, user/patient interface, filter and cover and humidifier (if applicable).	
Turn on RESmart PAP Device. Access Menu(s). Change Settings.	Will be able to power on CPAP, access, describe and change all settings in the clinician, patient menus. Will be able to install, turn on/off humidifier.	
Connectivity- iCode, iCode Connect, SD card, nPAP software	Will be able to access iCode on CPAP, access website, perform download of data and access report. Will be able to perform/understand iCode phone app, iCode Connect, nPAP Software, SD card.	
Cleaning/Maintenance	Will be able to describe cleaning requirements/procedures for CPAP and Humidifier.	
Interfaces	Will be able to show sizing tools, remove interface from packaging and identify components. Will be able to assemble, disassemble and clearly describe cleaning procedures. Review replenishment schedule for interface.
